A **Sensory Tour** is a journey that takes place precluding the sense of sight and urging the perception and imagination through the other senses. It's a "Visit to the Blind."

It is characterized by being an experience in which you live passively museum space and its contents, but we experience them in a fun way and reversing the normal code of behavior expected in museums. In fact, during a visit to the sensory Pio Monte della Misericordia **is forbidden not to touch**.

Not only for those with visual disabilities, but to everyone.

The tour is designed to achieve two objectives: to propose a reflection on the different skills and experience fruition not allow a ghetto.

There are two sensory visits. In a picture gallery and a church and being part of a single project, we recommend the presence of both.

The duration of the activity, by Dr Amelia Elvetico, lasts about an hour.

All participants will be required to wear a blindfold.

Reservations are required.

Hours: 10:30 am. People must be here 15 minutes before the start of the visit.

Admission: Adults: 10,00 €

Handicap: 5.00 €. Carers, if not users, free of charge.

Participants in one of the two sensory visits will be entitled to gratuity for participating in the second.
